BACKGROUND

Vision Share's is seeking a Specialist with a background in accounting who will engage deeply in being a high level contributing member of the Financial Management team and work with the CEO and Controller towards building the organization in a continuous process of growing, evolving, and diversifying. The Specialist will assist the Controller in executing the day to day global operations of the Vision Share Financial Management Office in delivering *The Vision Share Advantage*^m and leveraging the organization and its members' strengths in taking full advantage of domestic and international strategic opportunities.

VISION SHARE A/P AND A/R SPECIALIST ROLE

Vision Share seeks a strong day to day team member with communications, analytics, processing, strategy, and client relations skills to assist in steering the organization forward over the long term. This detailed and customer centered Specialist will ensure the flawless accounting of AP, and AR processes eye banks for global activities on a daily basis and will help to raise Vision Share's profile, execute on its vision, and increase the organization's connectivity to members, non-member eye banks, clients and the greater community both domestically in the USA and internationally.

In partnership with key Vision Share staff and while reporting to the Controller and the CEO, the A/P and A/R Specialist will assist in ensuring that Vision Share meets its goal of maximizing Vision Share and its member's tissue placement activities and advancing Vision Share's mission of restoring sight as broadly as possible on a global scale. By performing assigned accounting duties in a supportive role.

The Financial Management Team is responsible for all financial processes associated with Vision Share placement of tissue, timely remittances to provider eye banks and associated



vendors and receipt and application of payments. Specifically, the Financial Management Team will ensure Vision Share's success by supporting and maintaining a healthy accounting, payments and receivables process with vendors, clients and members. This position will serve collaboration between the Financial Management Office and various departments: Distribution, Marketing, International Relations and Business Development.

Vision Share is seeking a part-time early to mid-career Accounting Specialist with finance and accounting background needed for a demanding Nonprofit Healthcare Association. A potential candidate will have 2+ years of accounting/finance experience, preferably at a nonprofit association. Must have some experience in accounting functions which could include, billing, invoicing, receivables and collection, processing of all A/P functions, including vendor management, vendor and services contract maintenance, and special projects as directed. Ability to develop and implement systems for billing, collecting, analyzing, verifying, and reporting accurate financial information preferred.
